Scholarships under AYUSH Scheme for the academic year 2020-21

Applications are invited under AYUSH Scholarship scheme through ICCR's online portal <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/> from Mauritian nationals for studying Undergraduate/Post graduate courses related to Yoga, Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, Yoga Shastra and Homeopathy and Ph.D. course in Yoga and Ayurveda in Indian Universities/Institution/Colleges.

Applicants are advised to exercise due diligence & research in a dedicated manner on the specific admission criteria laid down by various Universities for each subject, and ensure that they submit all relevant documentation as required by the Universities in addition to the basic certificates mentioned in the application form. For this, they may refer to the Universities Handbook/University Grants Commission's website and the concerned institute's website for eligibility criteria. **The candidate has to fill 3 choices of Universities in the application in order of their preference.** If selected, candidate has to confirm/decline the offer of admission within 15 days of receiving the offer.

Courses and Eligibility for admission

Courses for which applications are invited are Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (BAMS), Bachelor of Siddha Medicine and Surgery (BSMS), Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery (BUMS), Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (BHMS), B.Sc in Yoga, B.A. (Yog Shastra); MD (Ayurveda), MD(Siddha), MD (Unani), MD (Homeopathy) and PhD (Ayurveda). Applicants must have studied Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) in their school leaving examinations, as this is mandatory for undergraduate courses. Similarly, BAMS, BSMS, BUMS, BHMS, B.Sc. (Yoga) certificate is mandatory for post-graduation courses. For Ph.D. in Ayurveda, MD(Ayurveda) recognized by Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM) is essential.

Age limit

Candidates should attain 18 years at the time of admission in Indian Universities /institutions.

Courses

(I) Under Graduate Courses

a) **BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery):** 5 1/2 years degree course including one year mandatory clinical training (internship)

Eligibility: 12 years of schooling with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)

b) **BSMS (Bachelor of Siddha Medicine and Surgery (BSMS):** 5 1/2 year degree course including one year mandatory clinical training (internship)

Eligibility: 12 years of schooling with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)

c) **BUMS (Bachelor of Unani Medicine & Surgery)**: 5 1/2 years degree course including one year mandatory clinical training (internship)

Eligibility: 12 years of schooling with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)

d) **BAMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery)**: 5 1/2 years degree course including one year mandatory clinical training (internship)

Eligibility: 12 years of schooling with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)

e) **B.Sc. in Yoga**: 3 years course

Eligibility: 12 years of schooling

f) **B.A. (Yoga Shastra)** : 3 years course

Eligibility: 12 years of schooling

(II) Post Graduate Courses

a) **MD Ayurveda**: 3 years course

Eligibility: BAMS degree recognized by CCIM

b) **MD Siddha**: 3 years course

Eligibility: BSMS degree recognized by CCIM

c) **MD Unani**: 3 years course

Eligibility: BUMS degree recognized by CCIM

d) **MD Homoeopathy**: 3 years course

Eligibility: BHMS degree recognized by CCIM

(III) PhD Courses

a) **PhD in Ayurveda**: 3 year course

Eligibility: MD (Ayurveda) degree recognized by CCIM

b) **Ph.D in Unani**: 3 year course

Eligibility: MD (Unani) degree recognized by CCIM

Financial Terms

The scholarship entails monthly living allowance, yearly contingent grant, HRA, tuition fee, thesis expenses along with to and fro economy class airfare.
