Admission to the Undergraduate courses in MBBS/BDS/B.E/B. Pharmacy, Diploma in Engineering and Diploma in Pharmacy under “Self Financing Scheme” for the year 2014-2015.

Applications from Mauritian students are invited in prescribed form for above-mentioned courses. Selected candidates will be allotted seats earmarked for foreign students.

Eligibility

- (1) **MBBS/BDS :** Minimum of 60% aggregate marks in 10+2 examination in India or its equivalent (HSC/GCE A level) with minimum 60% in Physics Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) and 50% in English.
- (2) **B.E. :** Minimum of 60% aggregate marks in 10+2 examination in India or its equivalent (HSC/GCE A level) with minimum 60% in Physics Chemistry and Maths and 50% in English.
- (3) **B.Pharmacy/
Diploma in Pharmacy:** Minimum of 60% aggregate marks in 10+2 examination in India or its equivalent (HSC/GCE A level) with minimum 60% in Physics Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) and 50% in English.
- (4) **Diploma in Engineering:** Minimum of 60% aggregate marks in 10+2 examination in India or its equivalent (HSC/GCE A level) with minimum 60% in Physics Chemistry and Maths in the first attempt and 50% in English in 10th (or its equivalent) as well in 12th (or its equivalent) Grade Examination.

(i) For admission to 1st year Diploma in Engineering course, the age limit of the candidate should be below 21 years as on 1.8.2014.

(ii) Some Directorates of Technical Education require that the minimum aggregate marks should be obtained in the first attempt.

Note: # The aspiring candidates for MBBS/BDS seats may have to appear in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) and obtain required marks to be considered for earmarked seats. Since the matter is under consideration before the Hon'ble Courts of India for foreign national students on above issue so candidates are advised to be in touch with Education Wing of High Commission of India, Port Louis and regularly check websites of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)/ Medical Council of India (MCI).

Aspiring candidates for B.E. / B. Pharmacy also are advised to be in touch with Education Wing of High Commission of India, Port Louis to know position with regards to selection criterion and regularly check the website of CBSE for further information.

A certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi that the candidate's qualifying examination is equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India for the purpose of admission to MBBS/BDS/B.E/B. Pharmacy/Diploma in Engineering/Diploma in Pharmacy courses **must be enclosed**.
