- 2. Contractors who fulfil the following requirements shall be eligible to apply. These criteria are indicative. Exact details are available in tender documents.
 - (i) Experience of having satisfactorily completed three similar works each costing not less than MUR 69.20 Million (excluding VAT) or two works each costing not less than MUR 103.80 Million (excluding VAT) or one work costing not less than MUR 138.40 Million (excluding VAT) during the last 7 years ending 30 April 2016. The works completed up to the last date of submission of tenders shall also be considered.
 - (ii) Should have average annual financial turnover of **MUR 170 Million** (excluding VAT) on construction works during the financial years 2012/2013, 2013/2014 and 2014/2015.
 - (iii) Bidding company should be a profit making company and should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the last five financial years.
 - (iv) Should have a bank solvency of **MUR 69.20 Million** (excluding VAT) as per details in tender.
 - (v) Joint ventures shall not be considered if created solely for the purpose of this tender.

EMD/Tender Bond shall be acceptable by bank transfer/bank draft/Pay order in favour of Head of Chancery, High Commission of India, Mauritius or bank guarantee (as per enclosed proforma in Tender Document). The other terms and conditions related with the EMD/Tender Bond shall remain same as mentioned in the tender document.
